Our class is called 'Ynys Bŷr' and there are 28 pupils in the class.

This page is intended to give you an insight into what happens in the year 2 classroom throughout the year.

This term 'Ynys Bŷr' class will study the theme 'Tenby' within the six areas of learning.

The Foundation Phase enriches learning experiences that enable pupils to be creative, imaginative and have fun whilst learning. Pupils are provided with a wide range of opportunities to explore the world around them by taking part in structured activities which engage and motivate them to become effective, independent and confident learners.



Home learning

Home learning is set on a Friday and it is expected that the pupils complete the tasks by the following Tuesday. The tasks are placed in the children's electronic file within their Hwb account.



Reading books

We aim to read with the pupils on a daily basis and therefore it is essential that they bring their books to school every day. Books will be changed when the pupils have read them and can show an understanding of what they have read. We have also provided reading books in a folder on all Hwb accounts for pupils, this is aimed to encourage and vary their reading materials.
